



Yosemite International, Harris Ranch, Reedley Municipal, Selma, Sierra Sky Park, and William Robert Johnston Municipal). Additionally, this plan incorporates the recommendations from the Air Installations Compatible Use Zones (AICUZ) Report for Naval Air Station (NAS), Lemoore, California that apply within Fresno County. The local agencies that have jurisdiction over land uses within the areas covered by this plan include Fresno County and the Cities of Coalinga, Firebaugh, Fresno, Mendota, Reedley, and Selma. The plan is prepared in accordance with the requirements of the *California State Aeronautics Act*.

The 30-day public review and comment period concluded on August 13, 2018. Documents related to the items were available for review during regular office hours at the Fresno Council of Governments Office located at 2035 Tulare Street, Suite 201, in downtown Fresno. The documents could/can also be downloaded directly at <http://fresnocounty.airportstudy.com/>. At the time it was supposed that the documents would likely be considered for adoption, by resolution, by the ALUC at a meeting to be held September 10, 2018 or as near as possible thereafter.

During the public hearing Dave Fitz and Kory Lewis with Coffman Associates gave a PowerPoint presentation on the Fresno County Airport Land Use Commission's Airport Compatibility Plan Update and Initial Study/Negative Declaration -- Presentation, Public Hearing, and Workshop.

Commissioner Duarte asked if during the one hundred eighty-day period following adoption of the ALUCP the local agencies would have to comply with the existing Land Use plan that is of record. Mr. Lewis said that there would be a new plan in place and that all projects or amendments to General Plans, specific plans and land use would have to come to the ALUC. Commissioner Duarte asked if there was a consistency problem that would have to be addressed and resolved, would it have to come back to the ALUC to get a consistency project by project until the local agencies plans were found consistent. Mr. Lewis said that it would have to come back to the ALUC.

Sophia Pagoulatos asked about the PowerPoint given by Coffman Associates. Ms. Pagoulatos commented about a notable change that she had not caught in the materials that was an increase in the AIA.

Brian Melikian, County Counsel said that the ALUCP and the Environmental Document could be considered all at the same time. Commissioner Duarte said that it would work.

Commissioner Duarte opened the public meeting on the ALUCP and the environmental document as was advertised on the notice for public review.

Commissioner Rapada asked if there was going to be a public meeting held. Ms. Veenendaal said that it was going to be later that night at FYI in the Terminal Conference Room from 5:30 pm to 7:00 pm.

Commissioner Remy asked if Fresno State and some of the agencies have also been notified. Ms. Veenendaal said that they all Fresno COG's database contacts were emailed and information on the Draft documents and public comment period were included in the Fresno COG TTC/PAC and Board agendas for the month of July. A notice was also published in the Fresno Bee.

Counsel informed Commissioner Duarte that it would be advisable to have a formal action by the ALUC to continue the date for adoption from presently scheduled September 11, 2018 to the proposed October 1, 2018 date, and identify that as part of the regular meeting agenda.

A motion was made by Commissioner Rapada and seconded by Commissioner Yrigollen to move the adoption date of the plan to the October 1, 2018 meeting and not have a special meeting on September 10, 2018. A vote was called for and the motion carried.

There was no comment from the public and the ALUCP update portion the meeting was closed.
