## Draft Greenprint Phase II Tasks

- Update existing maps and incorporate new maps as information becomes available, identify shortfalls or gaps in mapping resources, provide training to access and interpret maps.
- Outreach, especially to the counties but to other stakeholders as well, to increase awareness of the Greenprint, to solicit comment and participation, and to tell the stories the mapping and analysis are suggesting, including the challenges and opportunities.
- Establish a program to select and fund pilot projects that incorporate Greenprint map resources that provide real world utility and value.
- Identify opportunities to align the Greenprint with State and Federal initiatives (Central Valley Ag Plus, AB32 5-year roadmap may be potential opportunities) to enhance relevance and secure resources for an ongoing Greenprint resource mapping and analysis program.
- Review and document existing policies, programs and implementation tools in use in the Valley.
- Identify conflicts in regulations, policies or government actions.
- Identify strategies and tools used elsewhere that can help the Valley achieve economic growth and resource sustainability.
- Publish a guide for resource management, to provide a range of more specific policies and implementation tools that governments, businesses and communities can self-select to address their economic and resource objectives.
