A RESOLUTION BYTHE FRESNO COUNCILOF GOVERNMENTS POLICY BOARD INSUPPORT OF THE EFFORTS OF PROPERTY OWNERS AT MILLERTON TO OBTAIN SPECIFIC FUNDING FOR THE WIDENING OF MILLERTON ROADTO A 4 LANE DIVIDED ROADWAY.

WHEREAS, Millerton Road carries a significant amount of traffic volume and provides access to several recreation areas, residential neighborhoods, and employment centers; and,

WHEREAS, Millerton Road is currently developed as a 2 lane roadway but is planned by Fresno County to become a 4 lane divided facility, and,

WHEREAS, the roadway improvement plans have been paid for by Table Mountain Rancheria and have been approved for the 4 lane facility by Fresno County; and,

WHEREAS, all of the Environmental work necessary to construct 4 lanes has been paid for by Table Mountain Rancheria and has been certified by the Board of Supervisors; and,

WHEREAS, Millerton Road has a significant amount of recreational bicycle traffic; and,

WHEREAS, Millerton Road has a significant number of accidents that could be reduced if the roadway were improved; and,

WHEREAS, the Millerton Road improvements were estimated to cost \$24 million; and,

WHEREAS, the Millerton Road Project would be a logical extension of the 4 lane Friant Road facility previously constructed by Fresno County.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Fresno Council of Governments is insupport of the efforts of Table Mountain Rancheria and other Millerton property owners to obtain funding for the improvement of Millerton Road to a 4 lane facility from the intersection of Friant Road and Road 206 to Sky Harbor Road.

THE FOREGOING RESOLUTION was passed and adopted by the Fresno Council of Governments this 31st day of July, 2014.
