WHEREAS, the California Department of Transportation has been designated by the Governor of the State of California to administer Section 5310 grants for transportation projects for the elderly and disabled; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno Council of Governments serves as the Regional Transportation Planning Agency for Fresno County;

WHEREAS, one application was received by Caltrans from a Fresno County agency for FY 2019/20 funding from Central California United Cerebral Palsy seeking \$255,310 for three buses and one van to support their services in the Coalinga area.

WHEREAS, the project is consistent with the most current adopted Regional Transportation Plan (2018);

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Fresno Council of Governments:

- 1. Endorses the program to provide capital assistance to agencies providing transportation services for the elderly and disabled;
- 2. Hereby certifies that the recommended projects have met the conditions for the Section 5310 program and are also consistent with the Coordinated Human Services Plan;
- 3. Assures that the project, if finally recommended for funding, will be included in the Federal Transportation Improvement Plan (FTIP).
