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Washington Friday Report

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Congressional Calendar and Other Key Dates in 2020

House and Senate leadership have released their legislative schedules for the Second Session of the 116th Congress, which will begin when Congress returns to the nation's capital on <u>Tuesday, January 7, 2020</u>. See this helpful <u>2020 Legislative Calendar</u> provided by Congressional Quarterly. As you can see, floor time in the House and Senate is truncated during the presidential election year. Therefore, we wanted to provide you with advance notice for planning your trips to Washington in 2020.

Congress will be in recess for at least one week in January, February, and March. There is a two-week recess scheduled for mid-April. Both chambers will be out of session for nearly the entire months of August and October. Members intend to be in Washington for a "lame duck" session that will last roughly a dozen days between November and December, following the presidential election.

The Democratic National Convention will take place in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on <u>July 13-16, 2020</u>. The Republican National Convention will occur on <u>August 24-27, 2020</u> in Charlotte, North Carolina. The United States presidential election will take place on <u>Tuesday, November 3, 2020</u>.

Intergovernmental organizations have also released dates for major meetings. The U.S. Conference of Mayors (USCM) will hold its 88th Winter Meeting in Washington, D.C. from January 22-24, 2020 and its 88th Annual Meeting in Austin, Texas from June 12-15, 2020. The National League of Cities (NLC) will hold its Congressional City Conference in Washington, D.C. from March 8-11, 2020 and its City Summit in Tampa, Florida from November 18-21, 2020. The National Association of Counties (NACo) will hold its Legislative Conference in Washington, D.C. from February 29-March 4, 2020 and its Annual Conference and Exhibition in Orange County/Orlando, Florida from July 17-20, 2020. The American Public Transportation Association (APTA) will host its Legislative Conference in Washington, D.C. from March 15-17, 2020.

Signed Legislation

According to White House press releases dated <u>Friday</u>, <u>December 20, 2019</u>, <u>Friday</u>, <u>December 20, 2019</u>, <u>Saturday</u>, <u>December 21, 2019</u> and <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>December 24</u>, <u>2019</u>, <u>President Trump signed the following bills into law this week:</u>

H.R. 1158, the "Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020," which divisions A through D of the enrolled bill provides full-year funding through September 30, 2020, for projects and activities of certain agencies of the Federal Government;

H.R. 1865, the "Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020," which Divisions A through H of the enrolled bill provides full-year funding through September 30, 2020, for projects and activities of the remaining agencies of the Federal Government;

S. 1790, the "National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2020," which authorizes fiscal year (FY) 2020 appropriations principally for Department of Defense programs and military construction, Department of Energy national security programs, and Intelligence programs; specifies a military basic pay increase and other authorities relating to the U.S. Armed Forces; and provides authorities related to and makes other modifications to national security, foreign affairs, and other related programs;

H.R. 1138, which reauthorizes the West Valley Demonstration Project;

H.R. 2333, the "Support for Suicide Prevention Coordinators Act," which requires the Government Accountability Office to conduct a study of the suicide prevention coordinators within the Department of Veterans Affairs;

H.R. 3196, the "Vera C. Rubin Observatory Designation Act," which designates the Large Synoptic Survey Telescope as the "Vera C. Rubin Observatory";

H.R. 4566, the "Virginia Beach Strong Act," which clarifies income tax benefits for charitable cash contributions made between May 31, 2019, and June 1, 2021, for the relief of the families of the dead or wounded victims of the mass shooting in Virginia Beach, Virginia, on May 31, 2019;

S. 50, the "Columbia River In-Lieu and Treaty Fishing Access Sites Improvement Act," which authorizes the Secretary of the Interior to assess and improve sanitation and safety conditions at traditional fishing sites along the Columbia River;

S. 216, the "Spokane Tribe of Indians of the Spokane Reservation Equitable Compensation Act," which provides for compensation to the Spokane Tribe of Indians for the use of tribal land for the production of hydropower by the Grand Coulee Dam;

S. 256, the "Esther Martinez Native American Languages Programs Reauthorization Act," which reauthorizes and modifies a grant program to preserve and maintain Native American languages; and

S. 737, the "Building Blocks of STEM Act," which modifies several National Science Foundation programs that provide grants to institutions of higher education and nonprofit organizations to support science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) education research focused on early childhood.
