EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The City of Kingsburg receives payments from the Council of Fresno County Governments for the following allocations related to local transportation funding:

1. Article 8: \$159,367 for development, construction, and maintenance of streets.
2. Article 3: \$9,947 for bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

These funds are identified as "Special Revenue" for our budgeting purposes and are held separate from the City's General Fund. The funds are used for several permitted activities, including:

1. Street reconstruction (8th Ave, Lake Street, Kamm Ave Reconstruction, and Madsen Ave Bike Path)
2. Regular maintenance (potholes, striping, sidewalk improvements, etc.)
3. Street landscaping maintenance, including contract work
4. Street lighting improvements and utility bills

RECOMMENDED ACTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL

1. Staff recommends City Council accept the Funding Claim for Local Transportation Funds (TDA) and State Transit Assistance Funds (STAF) apportionment and authorize the Finance Director to sign and submit the Fiscal Year 2020-2021 Transportation Funding Claim.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Local Transportation Fund collects and distributes ¼ of 1¢ of the State Sales Tax collected pursuant to the Transportation Development Act of 1971. The City of Kingsburg's allocation amounts to \$159,367 for Article VIII and \$9,947 for Article III. Other agencies receive \$523,386 of Kingsburg's total allocation of \$692,700 (the majority of which goes to Fresno County Rural Transit Agency (FCTRA). Back in the 1970s, FCOG used to allocate transit money directly to the cities but they weren't using it appropriately and FCRTA was formed as a result of a lawsuit filed by transit advocates and Caltrans.

The total transportation funds allocated to the City of Kingsburg are distributed as follows:

FUNDS CONTINUING FROM THE 2020-2021 FISCAL YEAR, THEREBY COINCIDING
WITH THE FRESNO COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS
POLICY BOARD APPROVAL OF TDA FUNDS
APPORTIONMENT AND TDA CLAIMS PROCESS**

WHEREAS, the City of Kingsburg hereby submits a TDA Funding Claim for the Local Transportation Fund, and State Transit Assistance Fund of Fresno County continuing from fiscal year 2020-2021; and thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno COG has the authority to review claims and allocate such funds in accordance with the Transportation Development Act of 1971 and Chapter 3 of Title 21 of the California Administrative Code; and

WHEREAS, the Fresno COG encourages inter-jurisdictional coordination of transportation needs and increased coordination of transportation implementation plans.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Kingsburg hereby requests that the Fresno COG allocate the amounts approved by resolution by the Fresno COG Policy Board, from the Local Transportation Fund, and State Transit Assistance Fund to the named applicant for fiscal year 2020-2021; and thereafter for the purposes allowed under Articles 3, 4.5 and 8 of the Transportation Development Act of 1971, as identified in the attached claim and which is in accordance with the adopted Regional Transportation Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Kingsburg hereby requests that of the City's total Transportation Fund Apportionment for fiscal year 2020-2021; and thereafter, in the amount approved by resolution by the Fresno COG Policy Board, be allocated from the Local Transportation Fund to the Fresno COG for the purpose of conducting Regional Transportation Planning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Kingsburg hereby requests that of the City's total Transportation Fund Apportionment for fiscal year 2020-2021; and thereafter, in the amount approved by resolution by the Fresno COG Policy Board, be allocated to the Fresno County Rural Transit Agency for the purpose of conducting a transportation program consistent with the adopted Regional Transportation Plan.

BE IT FURTHER. RESOLVED, that the named applicant further agrees to provide the Fresno COG with such information as may be necessary to support its annual transportation claim.
