A. December 6, 2021 ALUC Action Summary

A motion was made by Commissioner Martinez and seconded by Commissioner Remy to approve the December 6, 2021 Fresno County Airport Land Use Commission Action Summary. A vote was called for and the motion carried.

B. <u>City of Fresno Public Works Department Proposed Municipal Code Amendment (Braden Duran)</u> [ACTION]

Braden Duran reported on this item. The City of Fresno Public Works Department was processing a proposed amendment to Chapter 15 in the Municipal Code. Modifications to this section of code required review by this commission.

The Fresno Municipal Code currently required that 100% of public improvements to a development were completed prior to a subdivider's bond being released. This specific amendment to Chapter 15, Section 3804, of the Fresno Municipal Code allowed the bonds to be released without these improvements in place.

Therefore, bonds could be released before infrastructure such as the completion of sidewalks, driveways, or street trees were completed.

Staff had reviewed the City of Fresno's proposed resolution and did not have any concerns.

A motion was made by Commissioner Martinez and seconded by Commissioner Krikorian to approve a finding of consistency for the City of Fresno's proposed amendment to the Municipal Code. A vote was called for and the motion carried.
